Dear Deputy Attorney General Marcus:

Boise State University writes to inform you and the Attorney General's Office that on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, the University became aware of a cybersecurity incident. At this time, we do not have information to indicate a breach of the University's system as defined by Idaho Code § 28-51-104. Nevertheless, we provide this notice out of an abundance of caution.

The incident appears to involve University files that were inadvertently publicly accessible for an undefined period of time. A selection of impacted files appear to include name and personal identifying numbers. The University is actively investigating the matter and has taken measures to address and contain the incident, including immediately prohibiting access to the impacted files.

We will update you once the investigation is complete.
